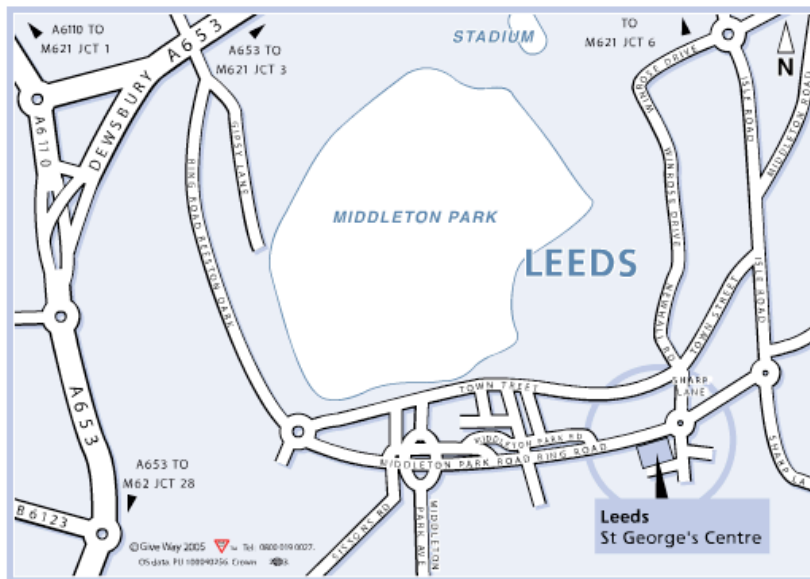


Details

To alleviate the pressure at the local A&E units, patients can attend our Minor Injuries & Illness (MIU) facilities. We can treat:

- Sprains and strains
- Broken bones
- Infected wounds
- Minor burns and scalds
- Minor head injuries
- Stitch cuts
- Remove foreign bodies from ears, noses etc
- Remove splinters
- Dress minor wounds, cuts and grazes
- Apply plaster of Paris
- Bites and stings
- Minor eye injuries

Guidelines for dealing with an Incident / Accident

- Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation.
- Is there a risk of further injury?
- Listen to what the injured person is saying.
- Alert the qualified First Aider who should take appropriate action for minor injuries.
- In the event of an injury requiring specialist treatment, call the emergency services – 999 (Direct them to Carlton CC, Town Street, Carlton, Wakefield, WF3 3QU).
- The telephone number for NHS Direct is: 0845 46 47 or see www.nhsdirect.nhs.uk
- Deal with the rest of the group and ensure that they are adequately supervised and safe.
- Do not move someone with major injuries. Wait for the emergency medics.
- Contact the injured person's parent / carer / guardian.
- Complete an entry in the Incident / Accident Report Book (located with the First Aid Kit in the Clubhouse kitchen).

Emergency Procedures

- Each coach / manager will hold an 'attendance register' for each session. This register will hold the emergency contact details of each club member together with any important medical information.
- If an incident/accident occurs, the coach or manager should follow the guidelines set out for dealing with such matters.
- Matters relating to child welfare should be reported to the Club Welfare officer.
- In the event of smoke/fire or other peril at the 'clubhouse' – please assemble at the 'emergency assembly point' (Car Park over the Road on Town Street), before alerting the emergency services.
